National Seminar on "Next-Gen Strategies, Opportunities and Recent Advances in Clinical Research, Pharmacovigilance and Pharmacokinetics"

Sree Siddaganga College of Pharmacy, Tumakuru, in association with Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS), Bengaluru, successfully organized a National Seminar on "Next-Gen Strategies, Opportunities and Recent Advances in Clinical Research, Pharmacovigilance and Pharmacokinetics" on **10th January 2026** at the SSCP Auditorium. The seminar aimed to create awareness among pharmacy students about emerging trends, career opportunities, and industry expectations in clinical research, drug safety, and pharmacokinetics. A remarkable 373 delegates from 16 colleges participated in the programme.

The seminar commenced with a grand inaugural ceremony featuring a welcome dance and invocation, followed by the lighting of the ceremonial lamp. The dignitaries included **Dr. Shalini M.**, Principal, Siddaganga Medical College and Research Institute, **Dr. T. Vithya**, Head, Department of Pharmacy Practice, Al-Ameen College of Pharmacy, **Dr. Nisar Ahmed**, Principal, Farooqia College of Pharmacy, **Mr. Alhas Ja Jiju K.**, Director of Medical Affairs, Arcolab, and Dr. Suresh V. Kulkarni, Principal, Sree Siddaganga College of Pharmacy. In her keynote address, Dr. Shalini M. emphasized the importance of innovation, ethics, and patient safety in

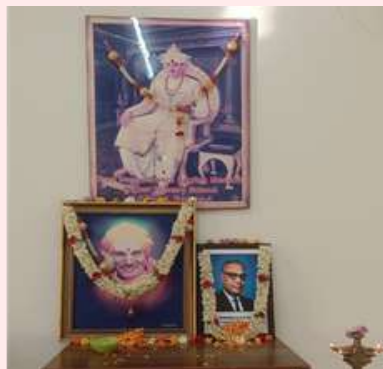

1st International Herbal Conference on Phytochemicals for Patient-Centered Care

The Department of Pharmacognosy, Sree Siddaganga College of Pharmacy, Tumakuru, successfully organized the Two-Day Hybrid Mode 1st International Herbal Conference on **4th and 5th June 2026** with the theme "Phytochemicals for Patient-Centred Care: Collaborative Approaches in Herbal Drug Discovery and Allied Health Sciences." The conference brought together 330 delegates from academia, industry, healthcare, and allied health sciences, with 116 scientific poster presentations, providing an excellent platform for interdisciplinary collaboration, knowledge exchange, and innovation in herbal drug discovery.

The inaugural session featured the release of the conference abstract book and addresses by eminent dignitaries including **Sri Jayavibhava Swamy (IAS Retd.)**, **Dr. Prathvi Shetty**, **Dr. Pandreesh M. D.**, and Dr. Kuntal Das, while Dr. Suresh V. Kulkarni, Principal and Convener, highlighted the importance of integrating traditional herbal knowledge with modern scientific research. 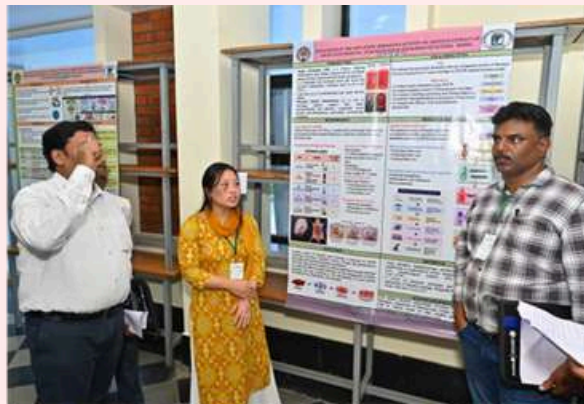

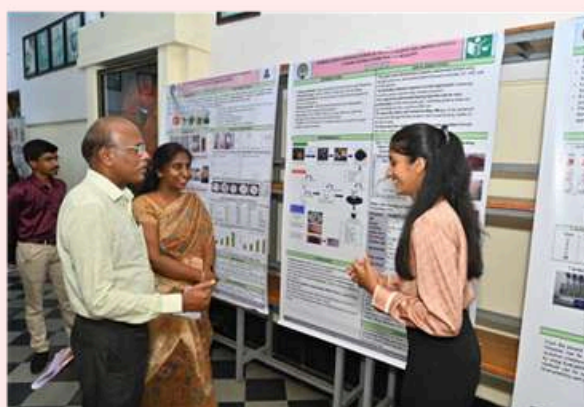

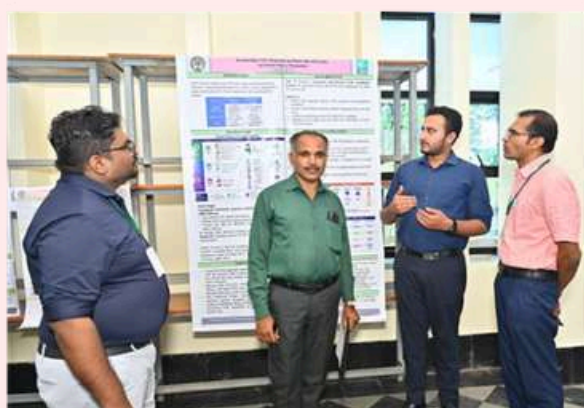

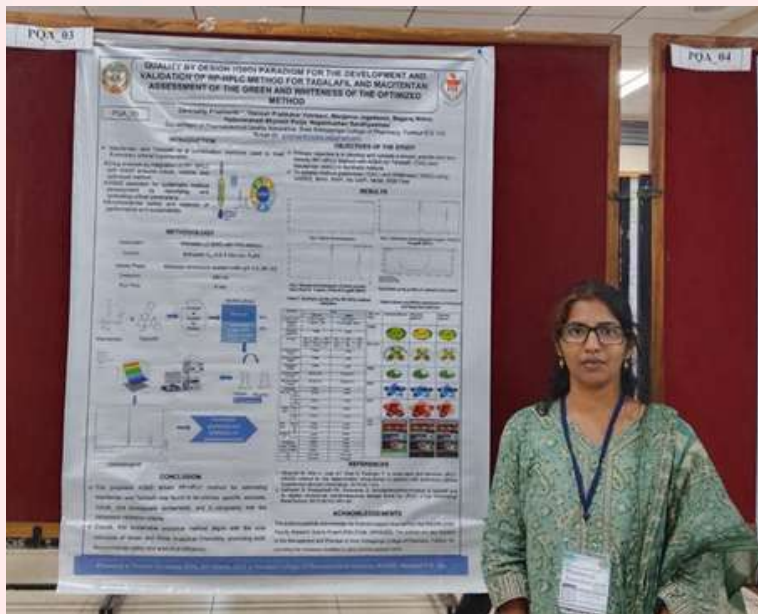

1. AstraZeneca India Secures CDSCO Approval for 100 mg Calquence in Mantle Cell Lymphoma Expansion



May 26, 2026

AstraZeneca Pharma India Limited (ASTRAZEN) has achieved a significant regulatory milestone with the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO) granting approval for the expanded use of Calquence (Acalabrutinib) in treating Mantle Cell Lymphoma (MCL). This clearance allows the pharmaceutical major to import and market 100 mg tablets for previously untreated adult patients with MCL who are not suitable for autologous stem cell transplant (ASCT).

2. Baxfendy® (baxdrostat) Tablets

Company: AstraZeneca

Date of Approval: May 15, 2026

Approved For: Treatment of uncontrolled or resistant hypertension.

About the Drug: Baxfendy (baxdrostat) is a selective aldosterone synthase inhibitor developed to help patients whose blood pressure remains uncontrolled despite multiple antihypertensive medications.



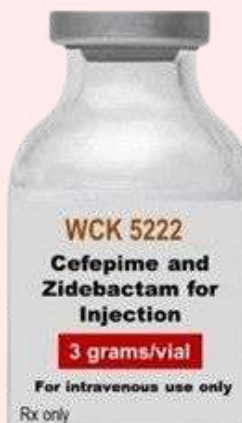
3. Zaynich® (Cefepime + Zidebactam) Powder for Injection

Company: Wockhardt

Date of Approval: May 29, 2026

Approved For: Treatment of complicated bacterial infections caused by multidrug-resistant Gram-negative bacteria.

About the Drug: Zaynich combines cefepime, a fourth-generation cephalosporin antibiotic, with zidebactam, a β -lactam enhancer that restores antibacterial activity against resistant pathogens.



3. Ranluspec® (Ranibizumab-hkdz) Intravitreal Injection

Company: Lupin Limited

Date of Approval: June 2, 2026

Approved For: Retinal disorders such as neovascular (wet) age-related macular degeneration and diabetic macular edema.

About the Drug: Ranluspec is a biosimilar of ranibizumab that inhibits vascular endothelial growth factor (VEGF), helping preserve vision in patients with retinal diseases.



4. FDA Launches Real-Time Clinical Trials Initiative

April, 2026

The US FDA introduced Real-Time Clinical Trials (RTCT) using AI and real-time data analytics to monitor patient safety and treatment outcomes during clinical studies. This initiative is expected to shorten drug development timelines while improving trial efficiency and patient safety.



5. Sustainable Extraction Technologies

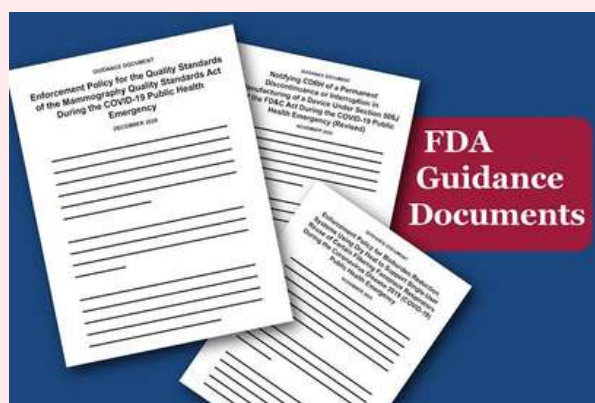

Modern extraction techniques such as ultrasound-assisted extraction, microwave-assisted extraction, and supercritical CO₂ extraction are increasingly replacing conventional solvent extraction methods to improve yield while reducing environmental impact.

6. New FDA Guidance on Pharmaceutical Quality (ICH Q8, Q9 & Q10)

12 May, 2026

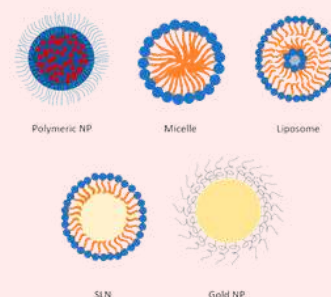
The FDA adopted updated ICH Q8, Q9, and Q10 guidance to strengthen Quality by Design (QbD), Quality Risk Management (QRM), and Pharmaceutical Quality Systems, helping manufacturers improve product quality and regulatory compliance.



7. Oral Nanoformulations Improve Antimicrobial Therapy

30 June 2026

Researchers developed an optimized Coenzyme Q10 oral nanoformulation that demonstrated enhanced antimicrobial activity and improved oral bioavailability. The work highlights the growing role of nanotechnology in advanced drug delivery systems.



8. First Oral Antibiotic Approved for Complicated UTIs

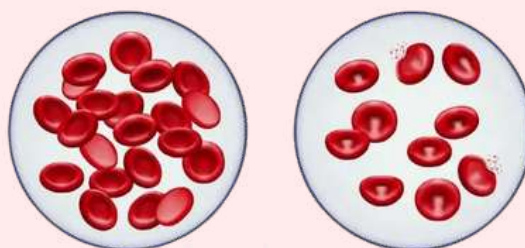
17 June 2026

The US FDA approved Utebzi (tebipenem pivoxil), the first oral carbapenem antibiotic for treating complicated urinary tract infections (cUTIs). This innovation provides an effective oral alternative to intravenous carbapenems, helping reduce hospitalization and improve antimicrobial stewardship.

9. First Oral Treatment for Thalassemia-Associated Anemia

01 May, 2026

Mitapivat became the first oral medication approved for anemia associated with β -thalassemia. Previously, many patients depended on blood transfusions and supportive care. This offers a new disease-targeted oral treatment option.
